
a Memorandum of Understanding was entered into on June 1, 2014, between the Imperial Valley College, the Imperial County Sheriff's Office, the Imperial County Probation Department to establish collaboration between the parties in furtherance of the Inside/Out College Program offered by the Imperial Valley College to incarcerated persons and outside persons at the County of Imperial Day Reporting Center; and

this historic collaboration marked the establishment of the nation's first "inside/out" model of postsecondary education between a county jail and community college; and

a recidivism study of the 60 incarcerated students attending the Inside/Out College Program during Fall 2014 through Spring 2018 found that only 7.4% of the incarcerated students were reconvicted, a recidivism rate substantially lower than the 54.9% recidivism rate of California individuals reconvicted post-release after serving their time in county jail rather than state prison; and

, the Inside/Out College Program is celebrating its tenth semester of classes on June 6, 2019.

that the Imperial County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes the Inside/Out College Program as having a significant impact in reducing recidivism in the County of Imperial.
